18.3	29.5	Tillamook , Oregon - Rock Lighthouse	Lighthouse viewpoint and beach access. Tillamook Rock Lighthouse year Light First Lit: 1881
19.6	31.6	Panoramic Viewpoint	Look north to Tillamook Head and south to Cape Falcon, Oregon.
20.9	33.7	Hug Point State Recreation Area	Tidal pools, hike to a waterfall.
